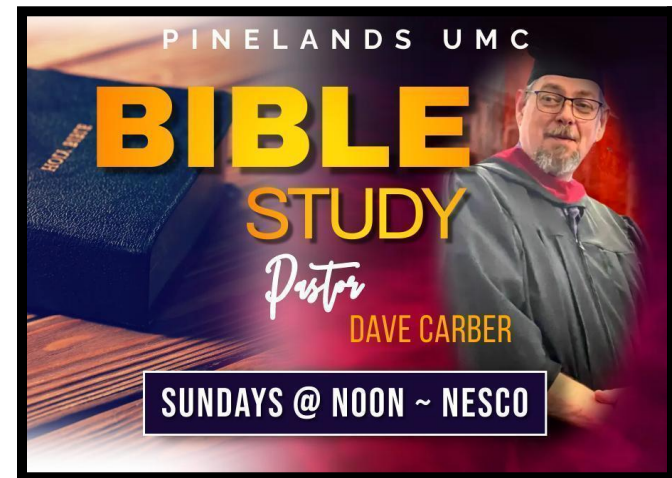
CHURCH NEWS
